While actions are limited by the parameters of plans, policies and procedures, they work with a considerable amount of autonomy.

This qualification provides a pathway to work for any type of organization that delivers outdoor recreation activities including, commercial, not-for-profit and government organisations.

EXPLORE YOUR QUALIFICATION

Instructor Development Course (IDC) – Instructor stream candidates only

Taking the step to be a PADI dive instructor is taking a step to an extraordinary life where teaching scuba diving allows you to share your love of the aquatic world with others while doing what you enjoy!

The IDC is made up of two parts - the Assistant Instructor course and the Open Water Scuba Instructor program and on completing the IDC you can attend an Instructor Examination (IE and PADI fees not included), the final step to earn a PADI Instructor certification.

Prerequisites for IDC: A PADI Divemaster who has been a certified diver for six months may enroll in the PADI Instructor Development Course. You also need:

- Have been a certified diver for at least 6 months
- Be certified as a PADI Divemaster (DM course is part of your AGI program)
- Have a current medical less than 12 months old (completed for your DM)
- Have a current First Aid certificate less than 24 months old (part of your AGI program)
- Show proof of a minimum of 100 logged dives (dives conducted as part of your program)
- Be a current PADI member (not included)
- Have all required diving equipment (not included)
- Have all required PADI books and material (not included)

ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS



Age: Be 18 years of age or over.

Interview: On-campus or phone/Skype interview before enrolment to determine course suitability (English level appropriateness, interests, intentions), identify relevant electives, costs, RPL and elective pre requisites.

English proficiency: To an “Intermediate” level. Determined by one or combination of: Intermediate Level of English OR IELTS Test Score of 5.5. Other recognised English Language tests such as: TOEFL iBT Test Score of 70, PTE Academic Test Score of 49, Cambridge English: FCE, OET Pass Grade, all tests to be no more than 2 years old, or Previous English study to intermediate level (must supply evidence acceptable to AGI) or Satisfactorily complete our AGI English entrance test or Demonstrate intermediate level English in AGI interview or Completion of Year 10 (Australia) or equivalent (New Zealand, USA, UK, Canada)



Previous activity experience and qualifications: Provide evidence of interest, experience in recreational, sport or fitness activities (interview, references, resume) and copies of formal qualifications and licenses in relevant areas of study (e.g., recreation, sport, health and fitness, SCUBA licenses or participation, swimming)



SCUBA stream: Swimming ability is required (200m, plus tread water for 10 mins), plus a pre-SCUBA questionnaire to be completed, based on answers a medical may be required at your expense, medical is required before commencing Dive Master program.

Note: Students can apply for Recognition of Prior Learning or Direct Credit. This may reduce the course time. See website or contact AGI for details.

DURATION OF THE COURSE



Course is delivered over a period of 62 weeks including 5 term breaks (10 weeks holidays).

The course duration may vary upon learners' prior experience, knowledge, and abilities.

AGI will deliver this course by scheduling 16 hours/week in-class face to face study consisting of:

- 8 hours at the classroom
- 8 hours foundation Skills Class (practical & diving activities) and
- 4 hours/week of study support.



Risk and safety management are an important component of the course, and it is essential to be able to manage the technical safety issues within each activity, as well as the general health and safety of people.
